- ✓ Can I retake an exam passed with 3.3? **NO**
- ✓ I failed the exam. Is the retake 2 weeks later? NO

 The retake is only possible during the exam period of the following semester if the course is offered.



Examination, study regulations

- A retake of compulsory master's modules is possible <u>one time!</u>
 A second retake is only possible for a maximum of one compulsory examination.
- Already taken examinations cannot be retaken; Retake of failed elective modules is not necessary-> choose another one next semester
